A short description borrowed from their website is reprinted at the end of this letter.

DATE: Saturday, April 28, 2012 at 6:00 pm

Bill has also found a good deal for that weekend at The DoubleTree Downtown. It's a 7 minute drive from the Brewery, has lake views and is close to the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. The Doubletree will block off some rooms for us if we let them know in advance. The rate is currently \$95/night. The next morning, a walk in the National Park could be outstanding, if the weather cooperates.

- Cleveland Science Center (next to the R&R HoF) open every day 10am 5pm
